

Membership Qualifications 2009/2010

CanSkate is Skate Canada's flagship learn-to-skate program, designed for beginners of all ages.

CanSkate Advance: No Minimum Requirements. A private coach is required for the Level 1 session.

Level 1 – No tests required.

Level 2 – Must have passed one preliminary test.
I.E. Dutch Waltz

Level 3 – Must have passed complete preliminary Freeskate test. (Elements and Solo)

Level 4 – Must have passed a competitive test (Juvenile and up) or Jr. Bronze Freeskate.

Registration Details

- Registrations will be processed on a first come, first serve basis.
- Competitive Skaters MUST be registered by August 31st to be eligible for the 2009/2010 competitive seasons.
- All skaters must be registered prior to taking to the ice and skating on sessions other than those for which you are registered is not permitted.
- Skater must ensure that your private coach is available on the sessions you choose.
- Blended Memberships: Membership is based on the highest level skater has requested.
- If the type of membership you desire is not listed in this brochure, please contact the Registration Chair at registration@bfsc.net prior to submitting your form.
- Please contact the Registration Chair for all Canskate inquiries.
- 50% up to \$500.00 of membership is due upon registration.
- Final membership payments must be complete by December 2nd of the current season (NSF cheques will be subject to a \$40 charge).
- Refunds – No refunds after 3 weeks for CanSkate and 6 weeks for all other programs.**
- Memberships are accepted any time during the season and will be prorated through November by the Registration Chair.

CanSkate is designed for beginners of all ages with the focus on fun, participation and basic skill development.

Children advance at their own pace, earn badges and other incentives. It is a group format led by an NCCP certified professional coaches. Professional coaches are assisted by trained Program Assistants.



This program offers an opportunity for the CanSkater who wants to advance to private lessons with the benefit of still

receiving group instruction. It includes a CanSkate 1 days and a STARSkate 1 day Level1 per week.
