Membership Qualifications 2017/ 2018

Pre CanSkate- A 50 minute program for inexperienced skaters age 2 -4 years old. Incorporating both on and off ice work, PreCan works on the essential skating skills and confidence building needed to move safely on the ice so skaters can join CanSkate.

CanSkate- A 50 minute program for skaters 5 years and up (or passed their PreCan ribbon) A dynamic learn to skate program that focuses on fun and basic skill development. Can-Skate centers on the fundamental skills needed to take part in any ice sport.

Rising Stars-A 50 minute program for skaters that have passed 2/3 ribbons from stage 3 OR who can skate the full length of the ice forward and backwards using alternating strides and can stop on demand. A dynamic program for those skaters interested in pursuing hockey, speed skating or figure skating.

StarSkate - A program for skaters of all ages to develop fundamental figure skating skills in dance, skills, freeskate and interpretative. This program is taught in both group and private lesson format.

* Registration for all programs must be complete 2 days prior to going on ice.

* Please refer to the bulletin boards at the arena and www.bfsc.net for all club policies and procedures.

Group coaching is included in all Junior and Intermediate sessions. Off ice training included for all levels.

StarSkate

Junior – Skaters must have completed their CanSkate Stage 4 badge. Private coach is not mandatory but private lessons are allowed.

Intermediate A – Skaters must have passed all 3 Star 1 tests. Private coach mandatory .

Intermediate B – Skaters must have passed all 3 Star 2 tests PLUS one complete Star 3 test or over 14 years old.

Senior – Skaters must have passed all 3 Star 3 tests PLUS complete Star 4 Freeskate/JR Bronze Freeskate or one complete SR Bronze test (Any Discipline)

Sunday Open-Available to all Intermediate A/B & senior skaters. Juniors can add if skating a minimum of 2 days already and have a private coach who will coach them on the session.

Registration Details

Registrations will be processed on a first come, first serve basis.

Competitive skaters **MUST** be registered by August 31st to be eligible for the 2017/2018 competitive season.

All skaters must be registered prior to taking to the ice.

Skating on sessions other than those for which you are registered is not permitted.

Skaters must ensure that your private coach is available on the sessions you choose.

If the type of membership you desire is not listed in this brochure, please contact the Membership chair at registration@bfsc.net prior to submitting your form.

Please contact registration chair for all CanSkate inquiries.

All memberships must be fully paid by December 1st, 2017 to remain in good standing. In order to reduce administration costs BFSC has implemented 2 payment options.

Installment payment (all cheques must be with registration form)
 25% due at registration- cheque dated no later than September 1st, 2017
 2nd installment due October 1st- cheque to be dated October 1st, 2017
 3rd installment due November 1st- cheque to be dated November 1st, 2017
 4th installment due December 1st- cheque to be dated December 1st, 2017

- NSF cheques will be subject to a \$40.00 fee, replacement funds (incl. NSF fee) payable in cash or certified funds. ***Any NSF or missed payments will result in the immediate removal of the skater from the ice until payment is made.**
- Refunds- Absolutely no refunds after 3 weeks for CanSkate and 6 weeks for all other programs. Skate Canada fee & BFSC admin. Fee non-refundable. See website for additional details and conditions.

Memberships are accepted any time during the season and will be prorated if applicable

Test Days: Skaters must be available to test on either a daytime or an evening ice session for each test session registered for. Test days are subject to change.
